## PARTIAL AND DENTURE HOME CARE INSTRUCTIONS

**STORAGE:** Place your appliance in a water filled container. You may add mouthwash to give it flavor.

**CLEANING:** Twice daily, clean your appliance with the recommended toothbrush and only use liquid soap such as Dawn, Joy, etc. Toothpaste is too abrasive and will ruin the acrylic. Once a week soak your appliance in a cleaner for partials or dentures. Please bring your appliance with you to all appointments so that we may clean them for you.

**MAINTANCE:** Should you appliance become loose and sore areas develop, contact our office for an appointment. To soothe sore areas, you may rinse several times a day using warm salt-water. Dissolve ½ tsp of salt in a cup of warm water. Let your gums rest by not wearing your removable appliances while you sleep.
